Theme of Seminar cum Workshop

Pharmacognosy is an important bridge between the pharmaceutical and basic sciences and also a vital link between Ayurvedic, Homoeopathic and Allopathic system of medicines. The demand of herbal drugs has increased enormously due to their effectiveness, easy availability, low cost and comparatively devoid of serious toxic effects. Despite its increased popularity, safety and effectiveness, herbal medicines have not been scientifically corroborated. The future development of pharmacognosy as well as herbal drug industry would be largely dependant on the reliable research methodologies for identification of marker compounds, structural elucidation of active Phytochemical and on the standardization and quality control of these extracts. It is the responsibility of Pharmacognosist and Phytochemist to explore the wonder drug molecules from the unexploited wealth available in vast resources of medicinal flora and fauna of both terrestrial and marine source. The present seminar cum workshop throws light on authentication aspects of medicinal plants and crude drugs, characterization of extracts, development of newer formulations and their evaluations.

- Develop skills to face the challenges in identification and authentication of medicinal plants.
- Awareness about the aesthetic media for better understanding of herbals.
- Know the important standardization tools for crude drugs.
- Provide the information about advanced technology in the area of research.
