Questions from students across the country were invited to be addressed by the HRD Minister. Questions were invited in the field of Environment, Water Conservation, and Education in general. The objective of this expert talk was to bring the best leaders from the young minds of the country. A total of 06 (six) students of the third year, as well as 03 (three) faculty members, attended this webinar.

INDUSTRIAL / HOSPITAL VISITS

Two-day industrial visit to Ajanta Pharma, Aurangabad was organized by SKNCOP for Second year B. Pharm students from 18th Jan 2020 to 19th Jan 2020.

The objective of this visit was to show the functioning of various departments of the Pharmaceutical industry thus helping them to grow as competent professionals. The visit commenced with a general overview of Pharmaceutical Industries by the HR Department and also about the company's growth and status. This was followed by students visit different departments and sections of manufacturing facility viz., raw material storage, manufacturing (compression and granulation) blister and strip packaging, finished product storage, and warehouse, water system, filtration system, etc. The students carefully observed the manufacturing of oral solid dosage forms. All the products are manufactured as per the regulatory guidelines of USFDA and WHO. Students were allowed to closely observe the online production of various products. Various large scales Pharma manufacturing equipment and its application were also keenly observed by the students.

This made our students correlate their theory with practical applications in Pharma manufacturing. This industrial visit had an added benefit wherein the students interacted with the senior researchers & got an insight of the expectations of industry from collaborative research & also understood the critical parameter to be stressed during the practical research work, to meet the requirements of the industry. Another objective of the two days program was to bridge the gap between academics & industry and amalgamate the two important pillars of the pharmacy profession. The success of the whole program lies in provoking the thought of industry-institute interaction & opening various avenues to the students. 47 Second Year B. Pharm students visited the industry. The visit was coordinated by faculty Ms. V.S. Navasare accompanied by Mr. Shyam Bachute and Mr. Anil Shinde.

PROBLEM BASED LEARNING (PBL)

Problem Based Learning (PBL) is a student-centric teaching pedagogy practiced at SKNCOP since AY 2011-12. In PBL sessions, students learn about a subject through the experience of solving an open-ended problem (trigger) The PBL process does not focus on problem solving with a defined solution but it allows for the improvement of other desirable skills and attributes.

SKNCOP in conjunction with the lecture based method conducts PBL sessions. PBL session are usually conducted in the B. Pharm programme for second year (Sem IV), third year (Sem V & Sem VI) and final year (Sem VII and Sem VIII) students.

In AY 2019-20 PBL was effectively conducted for odd semester students and the triggers/problems were discussed in the online teaching sessions conducted on Upgrad platform for even semester.

PBL has dramatically enhanced the knowledge, skills and attitude of our students. Enhancement in communication skills helped in better placements as students performed better in group discussions and personal interviews.
